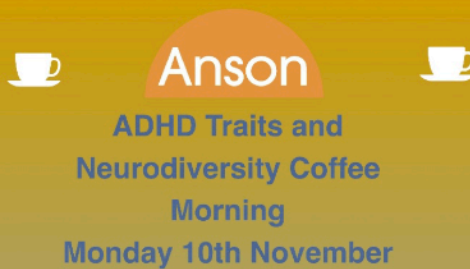

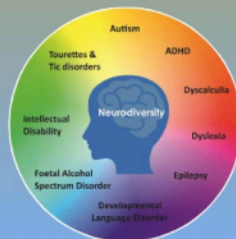
COFFEE MORNING:
