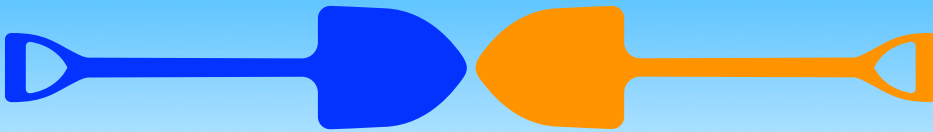

As many children unwrap new games in the coming months, we want to support you in helping them enjoy online play safely and confidently. Before your child starts a new game, take a moment to check the age rating, explore any messaging or chat features, and be aware of in-game purchases that may pop up. Talk together about trolling, scams and unkind behaviour, and show them how to report problems. If you have more than one child, remember that what's suitable for one may not be right for another.

Online games come in many forms from quick puzzle apps to creative world-building games, strategic challenges and action-adventures. Children play them across consoles, phones, tablets, PCs and even VR headsets, often chatting with friends or watching favourite gamers online.

Young people play for fun, friendship, creativity and a sense of achievement. With your guidance, gaming can be an exciting, positive part of their world.
