### **FESTIVE FILM FUN**

The festive season always sees screenings of new films into our homes.

The BBFC's detailed advice highlights elements such as violence, threat, language, and themes that may be unsuitable for younger viewers, helping families make informed choices. This is done by guidance called certificates such as U, PG, 12, 15 and 18.

Childnet encourages parents to stay engaged with what their children watch, recommending co-viewing and open discussions about any confusing or upsetting scenes. The NSPCC also stresses the importance of setting clear boundaries around screen time and ensuring that films and television programmes are age-appropriate, particularly during holidays when routines may be more relaxed.

By combining the BBFC's content information with Childnet's emphasis on digital literacy and the NSPCC's focus on emotional wellbeing, parents can create a safe and supportive viewing environment all year.
