THE 2026 BIG WALK AND WHEEL



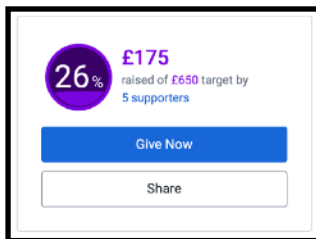
Big Walk and Wheel inspires pupils to make active journeys to school, improve air quality in their neighbourhood and discover how these changes benefit their world.

On each day of the challenge, which begins on Monday, schools compete to see who can get the highest percentage of their pupils walking, using a wheelchair, scooting or cycling to school. Our five best five days will determine our final position but schools will be entered into a daily prize draw for

rewards including equipment and accessories if over 15% of our pupils walk, use a wheelchair, scoot or cycle on that day of the challenge.

As part of our Eco and Sustainability work at Anson we are keen for as many children as possible to walk or wheel their way to school. Some of the prizes include new line markings for our playground. This would be a wonderful addition to our site - so let's get the legs, pedals and spokes working for the next ten days, beginning on Monday.
