## BACK TO SCHOOL: THE FINAL SUMMER TERM

**I hope you and your family managed to have a wonderful half term break. This newsletter is packed with information and key dates for your diary for our last half term this academic year.**

### Arrangements for the start of Summer Term 2

We look forward to welcoming all pupils back in school at 08:45am on Monday 1st June 2025.

### Attendance:

As a reminder, the school gate closes promptly at 9am. Children arriving after this time are marked as late.

As we begin the final half term, attendance remains a key focus for us. Thanks to the support of our families attendance has improved by this year and we are ahead of other schools nationally. Pupils with attendance below 90% are classed as persistently absent and will be closely monitored, with additional meetings and support in place for pupils below this threshold and where attendance is not improving.

### Rewards:

As we approach the end of the academic year, we're excited to share how we'll be recognising and celebrating our pupils' efforts, achievements and positive contributions throughout this final half term. We are incredibly proud that pupils are continuing to strive for the Gold rewards in attendance and behaviour. The positive culture of kindness and happiness at Anson is leading to high standards across the school. At the end of each year we recognise this with our Achievement Awards. This year pupils in every class who have embodied the school ethos and vision this year, as noted by the staff, will be in the running for the 'Pupil of the Year Award'.

During this term there will be further Achievement Certificates, Attendance Awards, Stars of the Week, TT Rockstars recognition, Gold Awards and The 2026 Annies Awards with all children celebrated for their achievements.

### Uniform Expectations:

Obviously we do not have a school uniform at Anson. However, children should always dress in an appropriate manner for a working school. This means that during the Summer Term open-toed shoes must be avoided as these are not safe for the playground. Strappy tops should also be avoided on hot days.

### Teaching, learning, curriculum and assessment updates

During this half of the Summer Term the Year One pupils will sit their Phonics Check and the Year Four pupils will take their Multiplication Check. The results of these, and the Year Six SATs scores, will be sent home in the Annual Reports to Parents on Thursday 9th July.
